Packing Tips

Remember you will be living with 8-9 campers in your cabin. It is a good idea to bring some kind of plastic storage container so that you can unpack, while you are here. Please feel free to bring items to decorate your cabin. Staff have used holiday lights, posters, banners etc in the past. Keep in mind that it all has to be removed at the end of the season and must be tasteful.

Bedding

- single bed sheets
- pillow & pillow case
- sleeping bag

Clothing

- jacket/windbreaker
- crazy outfits to use in skits
- Dance clothes(optional you don" have to dress up)
- pajamas/sleepwear
- jeans/sweatpants
- t-shirts, short-sleeves
- long sleeve shirt
- shorts
- socks
- sweater/sweatshirt
- underwear
- raincoat/ poncho (do not send and umbrella!)

Beachwear

- bathing suit (one piece)
- beach towel

Toiletries

- something to store and carry toiletries in
- soap & shampoo
- toothbrush & toothpaste
- brush/comb
- deodorant
- towels/washcloth

Footwear

- sneakers or hiking shoes (2 pairs)
- shoes to wear in the creek or on a canoe trip (close-toed)
- shoes to wear at pool/bathhouse (sandals/flip flops)

Other supplies

- sun block
- insect repellent
- fan
- alarm clock
- stuffed animals for homesick kids
- flashlight
- dirty clothes bag

Optional

- notepad/journal
- book
- Camera/Laptop -can store in the office
